1. The parade will originate in the 1200 block of Madison Avenue, Montgomery, Alabama at 2 O'clock P.M. C.S.T. March 21, 1965 and proceed as follows:
2. From the point of assembly as referred to in condition 1 above, thence West on Madison Avenue to the intersection of Madison Avenue and Bainbridge Street, thence south on Bainbridge Street to the intersection of Bainbridge Street and Dexter Avenue, thence west on Dexter Avenue to Court Square, thence east on Dexter Avenue to the intersection of Dexter Avenue and Bainbridge Street, thence north on Bainbridge Street to the intersection of Bainbridge Street and Madison Avenue; thence east on Madison Avenue to the point of assembly in the 1200 block of Madison Avenue as referred to in condition 1 of the foregoing.
3. All participants in this parade will conduct themselves in an orderly manner observing all traffic control and orders of the Montgomery Police Department involving traffic control; giving due consideration to other pedestrian and vehicular traffic along the entire route as set forth herein.
4. The purpose of this parade is to protest the Federal Court Order allowing a five day Demonstration March from Selma, Alabama to Montgomery, Alabama.
5. No participants in this parade will wear masks as same is prohibited by Title 14, Section 358 (1), Code of Alabama. See excerpt attached.
6. This permit is issued to be valid only for the date of March 21, 1965, and will expire at 6 o'clock P.M., C.S.T. this date. Upon the termination of the parade, the participants will disperse in an orderly manner.

With him will die the happiness of a Mother . . . the pride of a Father.

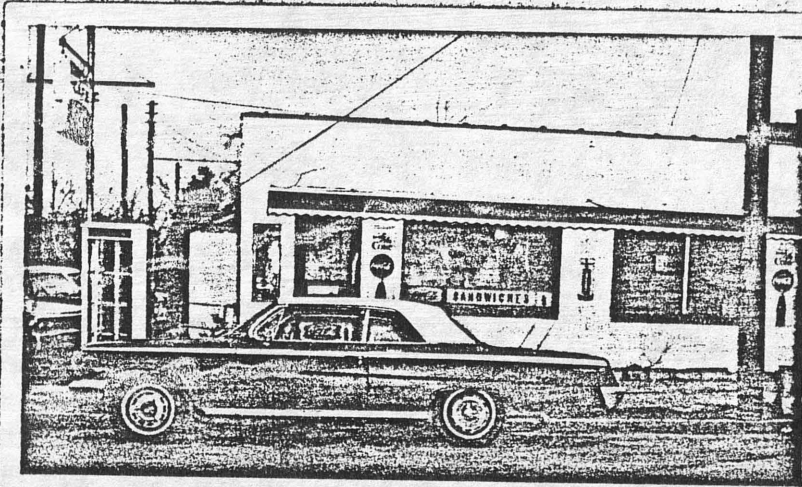

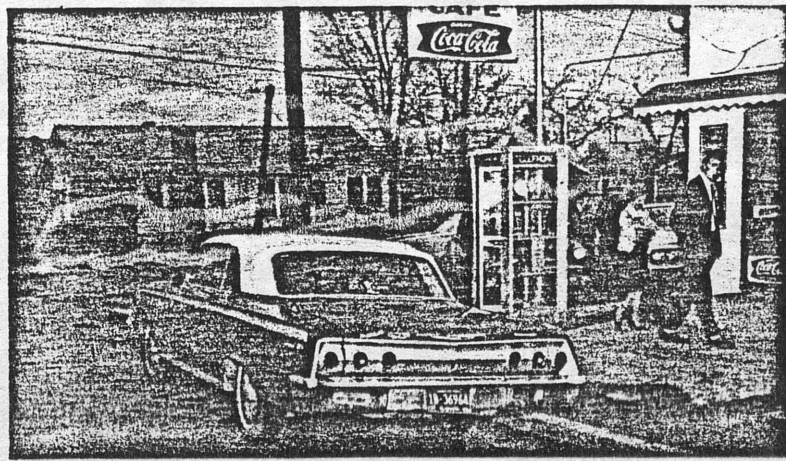
